 - c. Describes the support available for the proposed research.
- **2. Supervisor's Statement** (*maximum 1 page*): This statement is prepared and signed by the proposed supervisor and speaks to:
 - a. The significance of the proposed research program, and
 - b. Your plans to support and mentor the proposed candidate.
- **3. Current Common CV:** If possible, the CV should be submitted in Banting CCV format. If this is not possible at this stage, please review the Banting CCV format (available at to http://banting.fellowships-bourses.gc.ca/en/home-accueil.html) to ensure that your CV includes the information required by the committee.



4. If applicable - Additional Documentation (special circumstances):

- a. Justification for remaining at the same institution or within the same research environment from which the applicant obtained their PhD, PhD-equivalent or health professional degree
- b. Justification for remaining at the same location where the applicant has been affiliated with the proposed host institution (e.g., postdoctoral position) for more than six months
- c. Justification for extensions to the eligibility window for degree completion (if the completion date is not between September 15, 2020 and September 30, 2024)
