PAL Implementation Updates

Remember to visit CGPS' PAWS channel for the most up-to-date information on PAL implementation for grad. As of today, no additional information has been received, with the exception of a clarification on desigation learning institutions (DLIs). Starting November 8, 2024, all international students must be enrolled in the designated learning institution (DLI) named on their study permit. <u>Visit the CGPS PAWS channel.</u>

Student Supervisor Agreement Templates

The template for the Student Supervisor Agreement (SSA) <u>Policy 3.4</u> was updated to align with the student vacation policy (<u>Policy 13.3</u>) that was approved by council on January 19, 2024. Please ensure that you are using the correct template to ensure that *graduate* students are entitled to a minimum of 15 days of vacation per year, in addition to time off for weekends, statutory holidays and regularly scheduled university closures.

Closed Tickets in Jira

As a reminder, GPSOs are no longer monitoriting Jira. If a Jira tiket is reopened or commented on, it is likely that it won't be seen in a timely manner.

If you require assistance with an issue that was previously resolved in Jira, please submit a new request through the TDX Service Desk. Please include the STU number from the old Jira ticket in your new TDX ticket. This allows GPSOs to view the old ticket in Jira and even upload a copy if needed.

This process ensures your request is handled as quickly and efficiently as possible. Thanks for your understanding!

Application fees and adding a decision code

If an application fee payment was made through Flywire, it may take Flywire up to 14 days to process the payment. To avoid any system errors, here are some tips:

- Only applications with successful payments will appear on the Grad Admin dashboard.
- If you search for an applicant who is not on your dashboard, confirm that the payment was successful before recommending the application. Adding a decision without confirmed payment may result in system errors.
- Applications without successful payments should not be recommended. If unsure, please consult your GPSO.

Registered courses and deferral

At the start of the term, we encourage Grad Admins to keep a close eye on new admissions. If a student is unable to start their program and require a deferral:

- New graduate students should not register in classes until they know they will be able to attend.
- Ensure they are not registered in any classes. Work with the student to drop courses promptly to avoid tuition assessment.
- If the student is already enrolled, contact your GPSO before requesting a deferral. System errors will prevent deferral until all course registrations are removed.
