PALS Update

Effective January 22, 2025, all international graduate students applying to pursue master's and doctoral degree programs in Canada will be required to submit a PAL as part of their study permit application. International graduate students who have submitted their study permit application prior to the end of the day on January 21, 2025 will not require a PAL.

CGPS is working closely with the Provost's Office and College Deans to determine PAL allocation at the level of individual graduate programs. Units will be notified of these allocations as soon as they are available.

With the implementation of PALS will also come the implementation of the international graduate student tuition deposit. For all international students who accept an offer of admission to a graduate program on or after January 22, 2025, the international tuition deposit will be assessed and must be paid prior to the release of a PAL. Any student who has accepted an offer prior to January 22, but who requires a PAL will be contacted via Recruit and provided further information as to how they can request a PAL and pay the tuition deposit.

Admissions Reminders

With the busy admissions season now underway, we wanted to share a few helpful tips for graduate administrators to make processes smoother:

Transcripts and GPA Calculation:

- Check for missing items such as GPA calculator and transfer credit institutions on transcripts before submitting to CGPS.
- Advisors double-check admission averages. Start at the end of the transcript and work backwards.
- Include institution name, student information, highlighted classes on transcripts used for GPA, and grading scale.
- Include grading scale for all transcripts except USask.
- Edit GPA in recruit by opening the Application Review, clicking "Edit Review" on the right, then adjusting GPA and adding notes.

CGPS Conditions:

- Do not alter conditions such as PST, DGUA, DGMA, ENPR.
- Do not delete supplemental items, add notes under the preliminary items and choose the appropriate status.

Checking Student's Claim of Degree:

- Verify degree accuracy by reviewing transcripts. A student's claim of a 4-year degree may not be accurate.
- Admission Decision Codes:
 - o Fully Admitted (11) CGPS has all necessary files.
 - Conditional (12) Check for outstanding items post-admission.
 - o Probational (13) Ensure terms are noted in Department Review.
