Concurrent Curriculum

Decision deadline applied to admission offers

Following up on a February email from CGPS, on March 13, 2025, CGPS will be implementing a 4-week decision deadline for future admission offers:

- For programs without an existing deadline: Applicants will have 4 weeks to accept or decline their offer. If they miss the deadline, they'll need to check with their unit about the possibility of a late acceptance. If approved, a CGPS TDX general ticket can be submitted to request an extension.
- For programs that already have a deadline: Nothing will change.
- If a program prefers a different deadline: Graduate administrators can include the alternate deadline in the recommendation before sending it to CGPS and coordinate with their GPSO.

The deadline will be indicated on the letter of acceptance (LOA) and enforced in RMS Recruit.
