# Funding Announcement | Saskatchewan Pulse Crop Development Board Jacques Memorial Fellowship

Those wishing to be considered for the **2025-26 Saskatchewan Pulse Crop Development Board Don Jacques Memorial Fellowship** must apply through the application portal.
