What's the difference between the Summary of Proposal and the Outline of Proposed Research?

Both are a description of your research. The Summary of Proposal must be written in language that is clear to members of the general public and is limited to 1500 characters. The Outline of Proposed Research is a more detailed description of your research. You should provide background information to position your proposed research within the context of the current knowledge in the field. You have a maximum of one page for the outline and a maximum of one page for the bibliography/citations. Anything beyond this will be disregarded by the adjudicating committee.
