Western Dean's Agreement (WDA) Changes – Athabasca University

Athabasca University recently informed us of some changes to their internal processes that may impact outgoing USask graduate students taking classes through the WDA. These changes include:

- WDA students will only be able to complete graduate-level courses at Athabasca going forward. Undergraduate courses, even if part of a students approved program of study, will no longer be covered by the WDA
- Going forward, Athabasca will only accept a limited number of WDA students in a given year. Athabasca will post information online when they have reached that limit each year.

Fall ETD Submission Timelines

The deadline for students planning to convocate in the fall to submit final theses/dissertations to the ETD site is September 19th. The fall term add/drop deadline is also September 19th. Please be sure to remind any of your students who are finishing over the next few weeks that if they upload their ETD after September 19th, they will be required to pay tuition and receive the prorated refund following submission (they will be assessed tuition for the month of September). All students defending at any point in the fall term should be registered their respective 994/996 in the fall term (whether they plan to defend and submit prior to the add/drop deadline or not).

All students who are planning to convocate at the Fall 2023 Convocation must submit an **application to graduate** no later than August 31, 2023.

Special Topics Courses

A reminder to all academic units that Special Topics or Selected Readings courses (898, 899) must be submitted to CGPS prior to the course being offered. To submit the course, please

complete a <u>Special Topics form</u>, and attach the course syllabus. A <u>Special Topic or Selected</u> Reading Course can only be taught twice. For subsequent offerings, the course must be regularized according to the procedures outlined on the <u>CGPS website</u>.
